Step 3: Bake scones and enjoy! We will bake scones and enjoy them with tea. All ingredients provided.

Step 4: We will play a popular Victorian-era game in the garden or parlor. (depending on weather.)

Step 5: Girls will use the information learned and items made from the visit to act out an event at home or with their troop.
